#### Worlds Bid Info

All Worlds Bid teams will be judged by the **SAME 1 Panel of Judges.**

#### **PAID BIDS**

All teams in the following divisions will be given the opportunity to compete for a *PAID* Bid to the Cheerleading Worlds.

- ▶▶ All Senior Level 6 All-Girl & Coed Divisions
- ▶▶ All Senior Open Level 6 All-Girl & Coed Divisions
- ▶▶ All International Open Level 6 & 7 Divisions
- ▶▶ All International Level 6 NT and Globals Divisions

#### **THE PAID BID (\$25,000 MAX) WILL BE DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS:**

- **1<sup>st</sup> PAID BID** - Highest Combined Score of all Senior, Senior Open, International Open Level 6 & 7 All Girl Teams. This bid must be awarded to the highest scoring team among All Girl Level 6 or 7 world eligible divisions.
- **2<sup>nd</sup> PAID BID** - Highest Combined Score of all Worlds eligible divisions.
- **3<sup>rd</sup> PAID BID** – Next Highest Combined Score of all Worlds eligible divisions.
- **4<sup>th</sup> PAID BID** - Will go to 1 of the next 2 Highest Scores of all Worlds eligible divisions. This 4th and final bid will be awarded among these 2 next highest scoring teams. The Worlds Panel will decide between these 2 teams regardless of score. The Worlds Panel Judges will review both Days performances of these 2 teams and decide based on the performances which team has the best chance to advance at the Cheerleading Worlds regardless of which team's score is technically higher. Please note in the history of this rule the Panel has never skipped down and awarded a lower scoring team the bid through this process.

#### **AT-LARGE BIDS**

All teams in the following divisions will be given the opportunity to compete for 9 AT-LARGE Bids to the Cheerleading Worlds.

- All Senior/Senior Open Level 6 All-Girl Divisions
- All Senior/Senior Open Level 6 Co-ed Divisions
- All International Open Level 6 & 7 All-Girl & Co-ed Divisions
- All International NT & Globals Divisions

**PLAY. PERFORM. INSPIRE.**

**THE AT-LARGE BIDS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS:** At-Large Bids for All Teams will be based on scores.

- The At-Large Bid designated for the IASF International Globals or IASF Non-Tumbling Division will be awarded to the Highest Scoring team. Please note that these teams will also be in the running for any of the below additional At-Large bids where applicable.
- The Senior Level 6 and Senior Open Level 6 Divisions are guaranteed at least 2 bids (between Paid and At-Large) to the Cheerleading Worlds.
- The Next At-large Bids (Between 4 and 6 Bids - depending on how many Senior bid eligible teams received At-Large or Paid Bids will be decided based upon Highest Score of all bid eligible teams.
- The 2 Final At-Large bids to the Cheerleading Worlds will be determined by the Worlds Judging Panel. This decision will involve all bid eligible teams and will be made on a team's overall score and likelihood of success at the Cheerleading Worlds. (Please understand that since the inception of this policy the FINAL 2 At-Large bids have been awarded to the next highest scoring teams but the Worlds Panel has the ability to award ANY worlds eligible team the bid)

**NEW AT-LARGE BID EXCEPTION:** Per new USASF restrictions, JAMZ will no longer hand-down AT-LARGE BIDS to the next team in line. If an AT-LARGE Bid is turned down by a team, it will no longer be in play. If a team has already accepted an "At Large" bid from another company and opts to compete for another bid, they will be eligible only for a "Paid" Bid. They will not be eligible for another AT-LARGE bid.

**NEW BID EXCEPTION:** To be eligible for a paid AND/OR at-large bid from JAMZ, at least 80% of your program must attend a JAMZ regional and/or the JAMZ All Star National Championship (or a combination of the above). If your program's location is NOT within a 100-mile radius of a JAMZ event during the 2019-2020 season, THREE teams must register AND perform at the JAMZ all Star National Championship to be eligible. This rule is necessary to prevent/avoid the spoilage of a Paid Bid and to allow teams the necessary substitutions for Worlds. Exceptions to this policy can be made based on program size, program participation current and future JAMZ events and is at the discretion of the JAMZ VP David Sims.

**IEP Worlds Practice Space in Orlando:**

JAMZ is a proud member of the USASF and the CDIP (Cheer & Dance Industry Professionals). JAMZ is also proud to be the largest Independent Event Producer in the United States. Once again the CDIP is happy to be providing it's bid teams and all teams that have attended JAMZ All Star Nationals this year a dedicated FREE practice space in Orlando at the USASF World Championship with space allocated by priority to those teams staying on the CDIP Travel Package. Teams that took advantage of this opportunity last season can tell you how valuable this space was to their success. The space, with 3 full spring Floors is given priority to teams that book reservations on the CDIP Travel Package.
